PARK STREET, CROYDON

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate the installation of a hydrant and washout on behalf of Thames Water, they have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicular traffic movements in Park Street, Croydon.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place Park Street will be closed north eastbound (towards Park Lane) between its junctions with St George's Walk and Park Lane.
3. During the closure, the alternative route for traffic will be via St. George's Walk, Katharine Street and Park Lane, as appropriately signed.
4. The Order will come into operation on 19 February 2026, and it is anticipated that the work will be carried out within four days. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (b) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
 - (c) any vehicle involved in carrying out the specified works.
