ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED
THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991
AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS
WHITEHORSE LANE, SOUTH NORWOOD
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR AND EQUESTRIAN TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate sluice valve and hydrant works on behalf of Thames Water, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily prohibit vehicular and equestrian traffic movements in Whitehorse Lane, South Norwood.
2. During the said works, vehicular and equestrian traffic will be banned from turning right into Whitehorse Lane from the vehicular entrance/exit to numbers 128 to 176 Whitehorse Lane.
3. Whilst the banned turn remains in force the alternative route for diverted traffic will be via Whitehorse Lane, High Street Thornton Heath, Parchmore Road, Northwood Road, Beulah Hill, South Norwood Hill and Whitehorse Lane.
4. The Order will come into operation on 25 February 2026, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 01 March 2026. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required. The prohibitions will only apply during such times and to such extents as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in conducting the said work.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
