ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14
AS AMENDED AND THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT
1991

SELSDON ROAD, SOUTH CROYDON
TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate new gas connection works by SGN, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic in Selsdon Road.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place Selsdon Road will be closed between its junction with Junction Road and the common boundary of Nos. 110 and 112 Selsdon Road.
3. During the closure the diversion routes for traffic will be as detailed below. Addington Road, Rectory Park Road, Mitchley Avenue, Downs Court Road, Godstone Road, Brighton Road, South End and vice versa, or via Selsdon Park Road, Gravel Hill, Coombe Lane, Coombe Road, St Peters Road and vice versa.
4. The Order will come into operation on 16 February 2026, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed on 23 February 2026. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
