ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14
AS AMENDED AND THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT
1991

WILTSHIRE ROAD, THORNTON HEATH
TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate pipe repair works on behalf of Thames Water, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic in Wiltshire Road, Thornton Heath.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place Wiltshire Road will be closed outside No. 15 Wiltshire Road.
3. During the closure the diversion routes for traffic will be via Warwick Road, London Road, Langdale Road and vice versa, or via Winterbourne Road, Richmond Road, Stratford Road and vice versa.
4. The Order will come into operation on 14 February 2026, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed on 22 February 2026. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
