ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED
THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991
AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS

DOWNNS ROAD & VIRGINIA ROAD, THORNTON HEATH

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC & PARKING

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate gas main replacement works by SGN, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily prohibit traffic and parking in Downs Road and Virginia Road.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
 - a) Downs Road will be closed between its junctions with Virginia Road and Florida Road.
 - b) Virginia Road will be closed between its junction with Ingram Road and the common boundary of Nos. 86 and 88 Virginia Road.
 - c) Parking within the above section of Virginia Road will be suspended and waiting and loading restrictions will apply at any time.
3. During the closures the alternative routes for diverted traffic will be as detailed below.
 - Via Virginia Road, Ingram Road and vice versa.
 - Via Florida Road, Brickfield Road and Virginia Road.
 - Via Springfield Road, Carolina Road and Ingram Road.
4. The Order will come into operation on 02 March 2026, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed on 26 April 2026. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required. The prohibition will only apply during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
