TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate tram works and the manoeuvre of equipment and machines on to the tram tracks, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic movements in Bingham Road, Croydon.
2. Whilst the works are taking place the tram level crossing in Bingham Road will be closed.
3. The Order will come into operation on 21 February 2026, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed over two separate days, on 21 and 25 February 2026. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
4. Whilst the closure is in place the alternative routes for vehicular traffic will be as detailed below.
 - Via A222, Shirley Road.
 - Via Shirley Road, A232, Ashburton Road, A222.
 - Via A222, Outram Road, A232, Shirley Road.
5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (b) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
 - (c) any vehicle involved in carrying out the specified works.
