

PN451 - CROYDON COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14, AS AMENDED
SOUTHERN AVENUE & SOUTH NORWOOD HILL JUNCTION,
SOUTH NORWOOD
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate valve box repairs on behalf of Thames Water, they intend to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily close Southern Avenue at its junction with South Norwood Hill.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place, Southern Avenue will be closed between its junctions with the main carriageway of South Norwood Hill and South Norwood Hill slip road (fronting property Nos. 50 to 128 South Norwood Hill).
3. During the closure the diversion route for traffic will be via Southern Avenue, Lancaster Road, Woodvale Avenue, South Norwood Hill, High Street and reversed.
4. The Order will come into operation on 30 March 2026, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 01 April 2026. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further works be required.
5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (b) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
 - (c) any vehicle involved in carrying out the specified works.
