ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED
THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991
AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS

HALL WAY, PURLEY (PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO. 123)
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate gas main replacement works by SGN, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily prohibit pedestrian traffic on Hall Way, Purley (Public footpath No. 123).
2. Whilst the said works are taking place the entire length of Hall Way will be closed.
3. During the closure, the alternative route for pedestrians will be via St James Road, Downs Court Road, and reversed,
4. The restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any person involved in conducting the said work.
 - (b) any person attending for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity, or water to premises in the area, which necessitates entering a section of footpath to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
5. The Order will come into operation on 13 April 2026, and it is anticipated that the works will be carried out within four weeks. However, the Order will remain in force for 6 months to be reintroduced should further work be required. The prohibitions will only apply during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
