ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984 SECTION 14, AS AMENDED
THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC & PARKING

WOODSIDE GREEN, SOUTH NORWOOD

1. Croydon Council **HEREBY GIVE NOTICE** that to facilitate carriageway surfacing works, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic and parking in Woodside Green, South Norwood.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
 - a) Woodside Green will be closed between its junction with Cloister Gardens and the common boundary of Nos. 170a and 172 Woodside Green.
 - b) Parking will be suspended within the closure area and waiting and loading restrictions will apply at any time.
3. During the closure the diversion route for traffic will be as detailed below.
 - Via Spring Lane, A222 and reversed.
 - Via Birchanger Road, and Davidson Road.
4. The Order will come into operation on the 13 April 2026, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed over one night from 10pm on 13 April to 5am on 14 April 2026. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further works be required. The prohibitions will only apply during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) A vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (b) Anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
 - (c) Any vehicle involved in carrying out the specified works.
