PARK STREET, CROYDON

TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF PARKING/LOADING ARRANGEMENTS

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate safety during construction works, they intend to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily suspend parking and loading arrangements on Park Street, Croydon.

2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
 - a) The taxi rank outside Nos. 3 to 7 Park Street will be suspended to prohibit its use.
 - b) The loading bay on the south side of Park Street, adjacent to the junction with St George's Walk, will be suspended for use as a temporary taxi rank, allowing no stopping except taxis twenty-four hours a day, seven days week.
 - c) The footway outside Nos. 3 to 7 Park Street will be closed and pedestrians will be diverted to the opposite footway.

3. The Order will come into operation on 28 May 2026 and will remain in force for a maximum duration of 18 months.

4. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (b) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
