TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC ORDER
NORTH END, CROYDON, EVENT
ASSOCIATED RESTRICTIONS

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate a free public event in North End, Croydon, they have made a Traffic Order the effect of which will be to:
 - (a) Reinforce the existing pedestrian and cycle zone in North End, between its junctions with George Street and Poplar Walk, by closing it to motorised vehicles with barriers on the dates and at the times shown in the Schedule to this notice.
 - (b) Exempt authorised event vehicles from the above restrictions to allow them to enter North End during the event.
 - (c) Exempt authorised event vehicles from the existing at any time waiting restrictions to allow them to park in North End during the event.
2. The provisions of the Order will not prevent access being maintained for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to any road to which this Order relates, or to any other premises accessible from, and only from, such a road.
3. The Order will come into effect on 16 May 2026 and will remain in force for two days, as detailed in the Schedule to this notice.
4. The restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - a) any vehicle authorised by the Council and involved in the said event.
 - b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
