OXFORD ROAD, UPPER NORWOOD

TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate telecom works on behalf of Vodafone, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic in Oxford Road.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place Oxford Road will be closed at its junction with Central Hill.
3. The Order will come into operation on 11 June 2026, and it is anticipated that the works will be carried out within approximately six days. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
4. Whilst the closure is in force the alternative route for vehicular traffic will be via Oxford Road, Crystal Terrace, Hermitage Road, Central Hill and reversed
5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in conducting the said work.
 - (b) a vehicle attending for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity, or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
