ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14
AS AMENDED AND THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT
1991

WESTBROOK ROAD, THORNTON HEATH

TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate foul water connection works they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic on Westbrook Road.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place Westbrook Road will be closed outside Nos. 31 and 33 Westbrook Road.
3. The Order will come into operation on 01 July 2026, and it is anticipated that the work will be carried out within twelve days. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required. The restriction will only apply during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. During the closure the diversion routes for traffic will be as detailed below.
 - Via Howberry Road, Burlington Road, and vice versa.
 - Via Howberry Road, Northwood Road, Beauchamp Road, Moffat Road, and vice versa.
5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
