AS AMENDED AND THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT
1991

SELSDON ROAD, SOUTH CROYDON
TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate electrical connection works on behalf of UKPN, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic in Selsdon Road.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place Selsdon Road, South Croydon, will be closed southbound between the common boundary of Nos. 6 and 7 Ruskin Parade, Selsdon Road, and its junction with Cliffe Road.
3. During the closure the diversion route for traffic will be as detailed below.
 - Via Bartlett Street, Brighton Road, South End, High Street, Fell Road slip road, Barclay Road roundabout, Park Lane, and St Peter's Road.
4. The Order will come into operation on 15 July 2026, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed on 21 July 2026. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
