ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED
THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991
AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS
WOODMANSTERNE ROAD, COULSDON
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate the positioning of a crane for plant removal, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily prohibit vehicular traffic movements in Woodmansterne Road, Coulsdon.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place, Woodmansterne Road will be closed between its junctions with St Andrews Road and Southwood Avenue.
3. During the closure the alternative route for diverted traffic will be via Bramley Avenue and Southwood Avenue.
4. The Order will come into operation on 11 July 2026, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 12 July 2026. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required. The prohibitions will only apply during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
5. The restriction will not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
