ADDISCOMBE COURT ROAD, CROYDON

TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF PARKING

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate new gas connection works by SGN, they intend to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily suspend parking in Addiscombe Court Road.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place the disabled parking bay and shared use (permit/payment) parking bay adjacent to the flank wall of No. 130 Addiscombe Court Road will be suspended and waiting and loading restrictions will apply there at any time.
3. The Order will come into operation on 23 July 2026, and it is anticipated that the works will be carried out in five days. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
4. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity, or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (b) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
