The Croydon (Prohibition and Restriction of Stopping, Loading and Waiting) and
(Free Parking Places) (No.13) Order 2026

The Croydon (On-Street Charged-For Parking Places) (No.13) Order 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council on 20 July 2026 made the above Traffic Orders under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and all other enabling powers.

1. **The general effect of the Orders will be to designate new parking places at which vehicles displaying a disabled persons' badge may be left without charge or time limit in the following locations.**

Beverstone Road, Thornton Heath	Outside No. 38 and partially across the frontages of Nos. 36 and 40 (extension of an existing bay by 1.2 metres either side)
Chelsham Road, South Croydon	Outside No. 29 and partially across the frontage of No. 31
Colvin Road, Thornton Heath	Outside Nos. 20 and 22 (replaces one space in a permit/payment bay)
Richmond Road, Thornton Heath	Outside No. 58 and partially across the frontage of No. 60 (formalising an existing partial footway disabled parking bay)
Woodlands Grove, Coulsdon	Adjacent to the footpath and steps leading to Nos. 63 and 65.

2. Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation on 27 July 2026 and of all associated Orders can be inspected between 10am and 6pm, at Croydon Central Library, Katharine Street, CR9 1ET for a period of six weeks from the date the Orders were made. Alternatively, all related documents or further information can be requested by email to Parking.Design@croydon.gov.uk.
3. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made there under have not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks of the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
