THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991 AND ALL
OTHER ENABLING POWERS

PARK HILL ROAD, CROYDON
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate works by Thames Water to construct a thrust block and install two under pressure tees, they intend to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic movements in Park Hill Road, Croydon.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
 - a) Park Hill Road will be closed northwest bound at its junction with Coombe Road.
 - b) Vehicles proceeding in Coombe Road will be banned from turning into Park Hill Road.
 - c) The northwestern footway of Park Hill Road, adjacent to Sheridan Court, Coombe Road, will be closed.
3. During the closure, the alternative routes for vehicular traffic will be as detailed below. Pedestrians affected by the footway closure will be diverted via the opposite footway.
 - Eastbound – Via A212, Gravel Hill, Kent Gate Way, Addington Road, Glebe Way, High Street, Addiscombe Road, and Park Hill Road.
 - Westbound – Via Coombe Road, Park Lane, Barclay Road, Fairfield Road, and Park Hill Road.
4. The Order will come into operation on 08 August 2026, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed on 01 September 2026. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
5. The restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (b) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
 - (c) any vehicle or person involved in carrying out the specified work.
