CHIPSTEAD AVENUE, NUTFIELD ROAD & WOODCOTE AVENUE,
THORNTON HEATH

TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC & PARKING

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate sewer repair work on behalf of Thames Water, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic and parking in Chipstead Avenue, Nutfield Road, and Woodcote Avenue, Thornton Heath.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
 - a) Chipstead Avenue will be closed at its junction with Woodcote Avenue.
 - b) Nutfield Road will be closed at its junction with Woodcote Avenue.
 - c) Parking will be suspended and temporary waiting and loading restrictions will apply at any time in the following locations:
 - i. Nutfield Road - outside Nos. 15 to 25, 16 to 18, and 20 to 22 Nutfield Road.
 - ii. Woodcote Avenue - adjacent to the flank walls of Nos. 18 and 20 Nutfield Road and adjacent to the flank walls of Nos. 29 and 31 Chipstead Avenue.
 - iii. Chipstead Avenue - outside Nos. 26 to 36, 31 to 33 and 27 to 29 Chipstead Avenue.
3. The Order will come into operation on 01 September 2026, and it is anticipated that the works will be carried out within two days. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further works be required.
4. Whilst the closures are in force the diversion route for traffic will be via Nutfield Road, Warlingham Road, Richmond Road, Quadrant Road, Brigstock Road and vice versa.
5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in conducting the said work.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
