ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED
THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991 AND ALL OTHER
ENABLING POWERS
PAGE CRESCENT & LAYTON CRESCENT, CROYDON
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate gas main replacement work by SGN, they have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicular traffic movements in Page Crescent and Layton Crescent, Croydon.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
 - a) Page Crescent will be closed at its eastern junction with Denning Avenue, adjacent to No.1 Page Crescent, from 14 to 28 September 2026.
 - b) Layton Crescent will be closed at its eastern junction with Denning Avenue, adjacent to No. 1 Layton Crescent, from 14 to 28 September 2026.
 - c) Page Crescent will be closed at its western junction with Denning Avenue, adjacent to No. 20 Page Crescent, from 21 September to 12 October 2026.
 - d) Layton Crescent will be closed at its western junction with Denning Avenue, adjacent to No. 42 Layton Crescent, from 21 September to 12 October 2026.
3. During the closures the alternative routes for traffic will be as detailed below. Access to properties will be maintained.
 - Via Page Crescent and Denning Avenue.
 - Via Layton Crescent and Denning Avenue.
4. The Order will come into operation on 14 September 2026, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed as detailed above.
5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) a vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
