ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED
THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991
AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS

QUEEN ELIZABETH'S DRIVE, NEW ADDINGTON

TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate blockage clearance works on behalf of Openreach, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic in Queen Elizabeth's Drive.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place, the road will be closed outside Nos. 140 to 148 Queen Elizabeth's Drive.
3. The Order will come into operation on 14 September 2026, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 16 September 2026. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
4. During the closure the alternative route for traffic will be via Queen Elizabeth's Drive, Arnhem Drive and Salcot Crescent and reversed.
5. The prohibition will only apply during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
6. The restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) A vehicle involved in the said work.
 - (b) A vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) Anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.
