ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14

BRICKWOOD ROAD, CROYDON

TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC & PARKING

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate new gas connection works by SGN, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic and parking in Brickwood Road, Croydon.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
 - a) Brickwood Road will be closed between the rear boundary of No. 57 Addiscombe Road and the common boundary of Nos. 6 and 8 Brickwood Road.
 - b) Parking places outside Nos. 3 to 13 and Nos. 8 to 16 Brickwood Road will be suspended and waiting and loading restrictions prohibiting parking will apply in those bays at any time.
 - c) one-way working in Brickwood Road will be suspended to allow two-way traffic.
3. During the closure traffic will be diverted via Addiscombe Road, Chisholm Road and Cedar Road.
4. The Order will come into operation on 21 September 2026, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed within five days. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
5. The restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) A vehicle involved in the said work.
 - (b) A vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) Anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
6. The restrictions will only apply during such times and to such an extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
