ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14
AS AMENDED AND THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT
1991

MIDHURST AVENUE, CROYDON
TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC & PARKING

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate a district meter exchange on behalf of Thames Water, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic and parking in Midhurst Avenue, Croydon.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
 - a) The cycle lane in Midhurst Avenue at its junction with Sutherland Road will be closed between that junction and the common boundary of Nos. 62 and 64 Midhurst Avenue.
 - b) Parking bays will be suspended and waiting and loading restrictions will apply at any time outside Nos. 45 to 53 Midhurst Avenue.
3. During the closure cyclists will be asked to dismount and be diverted via the footway.
4. The Order will come into operation on 17 September 2026, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed on 20 September 2026. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
