NORTH END, CROYDON

TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate the replacement of temporary footway surfacing with permanent paving slabs by Thames Water, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic in North End Croydon.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
 - a) The bus lane on the north-east side of North End will be closed from the common boundary of Nos. 168 and 170 North End to common boundary of West Croydon Station and No. 10 London Road.
 - b) The northeastern footway of North End will be closed outside No. 172 North End.
3. The Order will come into operation on 20 September 2026, and it is anticipated that the work will be carried out in one day. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
4. Whilst the closures are in force buses will be diverted into the main carriageway and pedestrians will be diverted via a walkway in the bus lane.
5. The restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any person or vehicle involved in conducting the said work.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
