# NOTICE OF ELECTION

1. An Election will be held for a Member of Parliament for each of the Parliamentary Constituencies of Croydon Central, Croydon North and Croydon South.
2. Nomination papers and other documents can be obtained from the Town Hall, Katharine Street, Croydon, CR9 1DE (telephone 020 8760 5591).
3. Nomination papers and a deposit of £500, in legal tender or by banker's draft, must be delivered to the (Acting) Returning Officer, Town Hall, Katharine Street, Croydon, CR9 1DE, on any day after the date of this notice, on Monday to Thursday **10am to 4pm** but no later than **4pm on Thursday 14 November 2019**.
4. If any election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday 12 December 2019**.
5. Applications to register to vote or to vote by post or proxy should be made to the Electoral Registration Officer at the Town Hall, Katharine Street, Croydon, CR9 1DE, based on the statutory deadlines set out below.

Applications for an emergency proxy vote on the grounds of physical incapacity or work/service/ See (1) below	<b>5pm on Thursday 12 December 2019</b>

(1)The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 4 December 2019. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 4 December 2019.
