RESOLVED to:

1. approve the award of contract to administer the delivery of the Croydon Enterprise Loan Fund for an initial 3.5 year period at a value of £543,080, with the option to extend for up to a further 3.5 years (1.5+1+1) to a maximum contract period of 7 years at a maximum contract value of £1,093,750 to the Delivery Partner detailed in the associated Part B report.
