**Publicity in connection with key decisions –
general exception - regulation 10(3)**

The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to
Information) (England) Regulations 2012 (“The Regulations”)

When twenty-eight clear days’ notice cannot be given of the intention to take a decision which meets the Council Constitution definition of a Key Decision, a notice has to be issued outlining why it would be impracticable to defer the item to enable twenty-eight days’ notice can be given.

Further to the Regulation 10(1) notice dated 23 September 2016, and in accordance with Regulation 10(3), notice is hereby given that:-

1. The requirements of Regulation 10(1) have been complied with and the Chair of the Scrutiny & Overview Committee has been advised of the purpose of the report to be considered; and
2. Compliance with Regulation 9 in relation to the key decisions to be contained in the report on the Autumn Financial Statement is not practicable, as the Cabinet is required to consider decisions on the following issues no later than this Cabinet meeting scheduled for 10 October 2016
 - 1) To approve a discretionary business rates relief policy
 - 2) To accept the four year settlement from government and submit the efficiency plan as set out in the report
